



OBS software tutorial:

How to easily alternate between different video streams to energize your distance courses or presentations

First steps

- **Download OBS** on obsproject.com
- **Add a scene** by clicking on « + » in the « scenes » window
- **Add your webcam to this scene:**

Select « + » and « video capture device », then create a new source and select your webcam



- **Create a second scene displaying both your webcam and another window (web browser):**

Proceed as previously, add your webcam to your new scene and reduce its size.

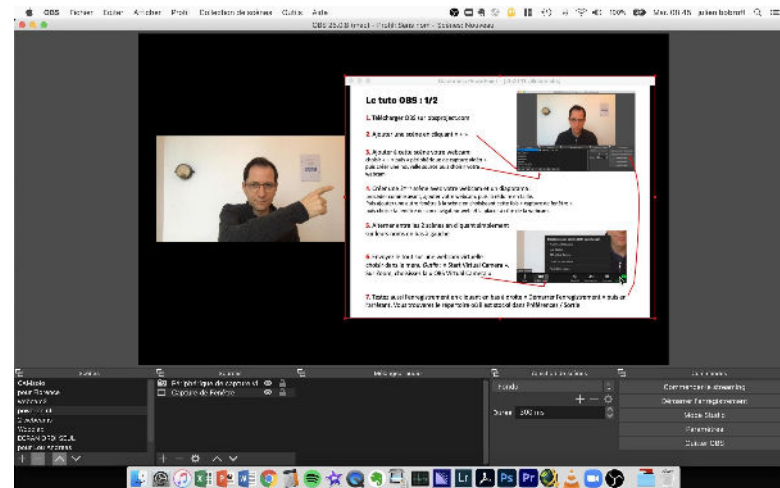
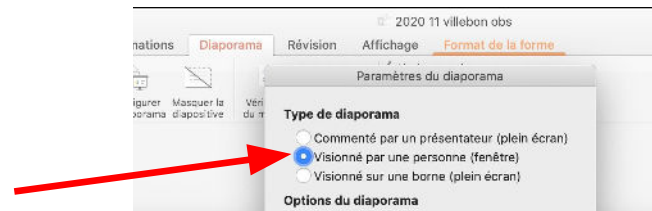
Then add another window to your scene, this time selecting « window capture » and choosing your web browser window and placing it next to your webcam.

Tip : you can crop the different windows by pressing alt and moving the window borders.

- **Alternate between the 2 scenes** by simply clicking on their name on the bottom left window

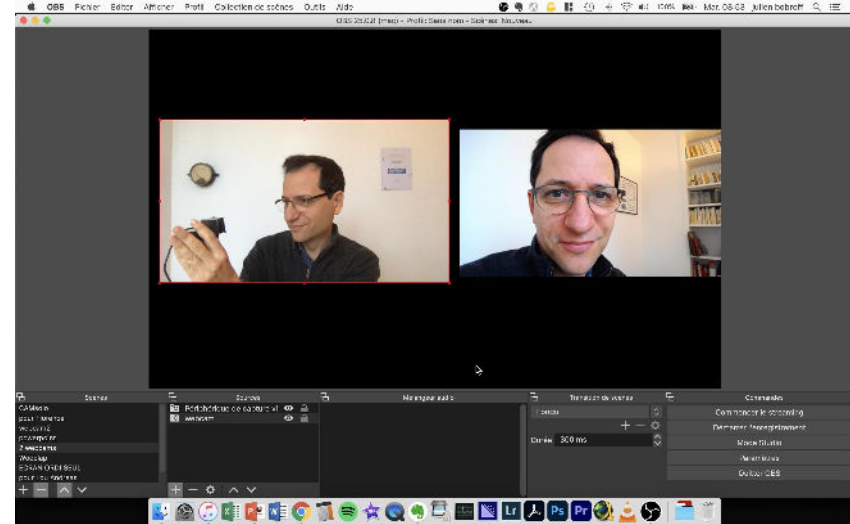
● Add a PowerPoint slide show with a webcam

- In PowerPoint, go in the « **slide show set up** » menu and select « **browsed by another individual (window)** »
- Launch the slide show and reduce the window size.
- Create a new scene in OBS with you webcam and another “window capture” where you select your slide show. Adjust the sizes like in the picture:



● Add a second webcam

- If you have a second webcam, create a scene by adding both of your webcams through the « video capture device » option
- Otherwise, use your smartphone as a second webcam: you can find our tutorial [here](#)!



Start

- Send your stream to a **virtual webcam** :
in the OBS tools menu, select « Start Virtual Camera ».

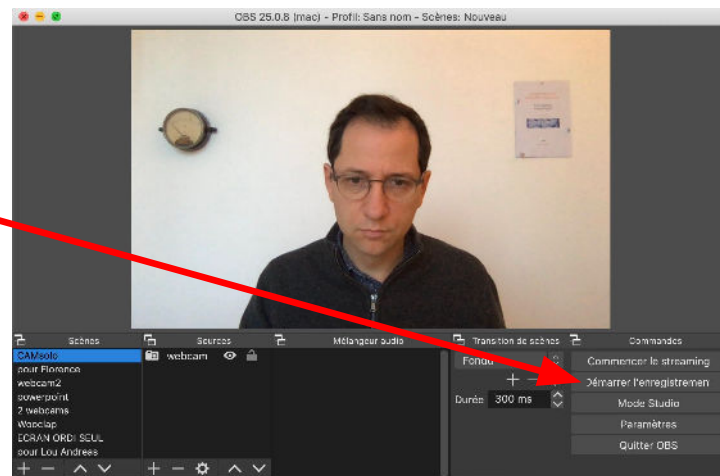
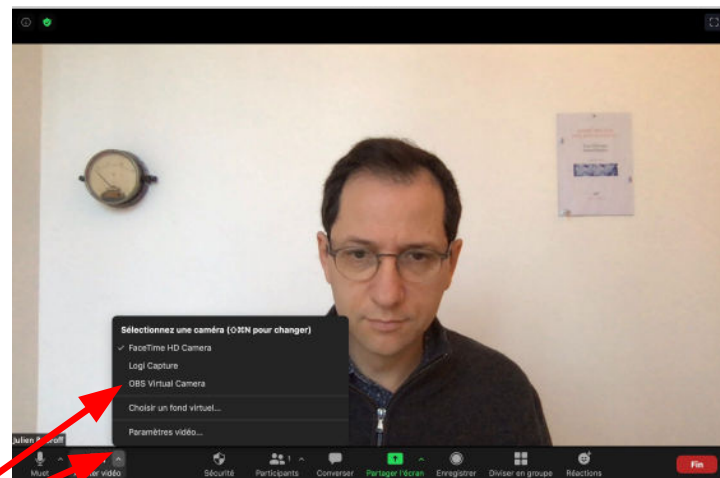
If you do not see this option, you have to install it :

on Mac : <https://tinyurl.com/macvirtualcam>

on Windows : <https://tinyurl.com/pcvirtualcam>

Then, in Zoom or any other videoconferencing software,
pick “OBS Virtual Webcam” in your webcam options

- **You can also record your stream:** in the bottom right corner, click on « **Start recording** » and stop whenever you are done. You can find where it has been saved by clicking File / Show recordings.





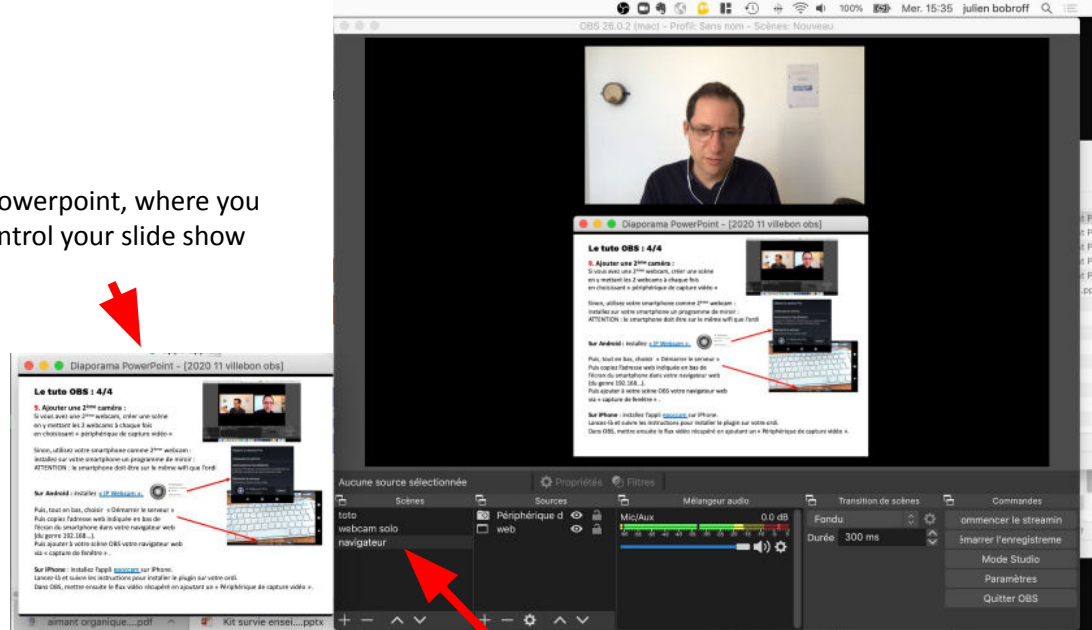

Then, share your stream as follow:

- On **Collaborate** : open the Collaborate side bar on the bottom right corner of your screen, click on “share content”, then on “share webcam” and select “OBS Virtual Webcam”
- On **Zoom** : click on “shared screen”, and then select “2nd webcam content” in the “advanced” tab
